



Technical Car Construction Regulations 2019 2.0-litre Pinto Engine – Rev. Limiter Wiring

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2.0-litre Pinto Engine – Rev. Limiter Wiring

- Following observations made during the opening two weekends of the season, BriSCA F2 wishes to **emphasise** the following **existing** technical regulations to all drivers using the 2.0-litre Ford Pinto engine.
 - 231.16.12** *The standard BriSCA F2 control rev. limiter and associated wiring loom, designed for the permitted Pinto engine, and supplied by BriSCA F2, MUST be fitted and used at all times. This rev. limiter has an RPM limit set at 7,800 RPM.*
 - 231.16.13** *The use of any other rev. limiter and/or associated wiring loom, other than the BriSCA F2 control components, is NOT permitted.*
 - 231.16.14** *Disconnection of the rev. limiter through mechanical, electronic, or any other means is NOT permitted.*
- For the avoidance of doubt...
 - The installation/use of secondary ignition wiring looms or additional non-specified wiring ...and/or...
 - The fitting of additional plugs/connectors (other than those required to directly connect the mandated loom to the distributor, amplifier, coil and positive/negative feeds) ...and/or...
 - The fitting of by-pass wiring ...and/or...
 - The wiring/connection of the supplied rev. limiter and wiring loom in any manner other than described in the installation instructions provided by OMEX Technologies Ltd.
...are NOT permitted.
- Any driver found to be...
 - Using additional wiring looms/components in the ignition system ...and/or...
 - By-passing the control rev. limiter ...and/or...
 - Installing a means to bypass the control rev. limiter ...and/or...
 - Refusing inspection by a licensed official
 ...will be subject to the normal disciplinary procedures. If proven, such actions may lead to a 6-month suspension of a driver's racing licence (the standard penalty for engine irregularities).
- Any driver seeking to take any action in contravention of the documented technical regulations MUST seek, and be granted, special permission from the meeting steward PRIOR to taking such action.
